Show and Tell

Dear Parents,

In Grade 1 this year, students will be participating in show and tell presentations. We would like *Show and Tell* to be an activity that encourages students to share their interests and hobbies while also helping them get to know their classmates and build classroom community. It's also a great opportunity for students to practice speaking in front of their peers.

There will be a given topic for each *Show and Tell* week. Children will be asked to bring a momento, book, photo, drawing, something they have made, or a toy to school (weapons or violent characters **will not** be accepted). If the object has significant value either emotionally or monetary, I would recommend drawing a picture on the back of the presentation sheet rather than bringing it to school.

Each student should present for 3-5 minutes. A *Show and Tell* planning template will be shared with the students on Friday the previous week and are due back to class on **Monday**. I would suggest that the students plan their presentation beforehand and practice it at home on the weekend to gain some confidence with the topic. The item(s) can be brought to school in a bag or box (not clear).

How to Prepare







In order for *Show and Tell* to be a successful and valuable part of our schedule, students should prepare at home. Please take time at home to help your child practice presenting his/her *Show and Tell* item to an audience and answering "Why?" questions. Attached to this letter is the schedule for our show and tells and we will try to stick to this throughout this term. If your child is sick or absent on their show and tell day we will try to find time to do it on another day.

I will give students feedback by marking a simple rubric (please see the example) and writing a short comment. Please go over this rubric with your child so they understand what is expected of them.
